Students proudly explaining their science projects to the parents.

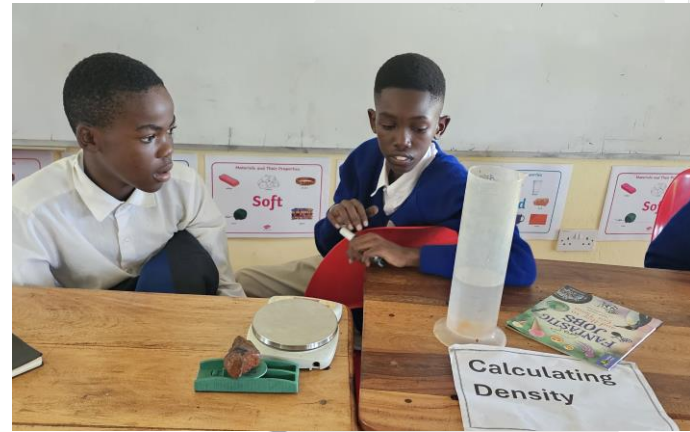


Everyone is busy listening to the students during the science day.
