General Reminders

Parents are kindly encouraged to support and monitor their child's homework. Please ensure that all homework is completed and signed by an adult. It is also important to check that your child brings the correct kit and equipment for each school day. In addition, please note that only healthy food is permitted at school. Items such as chips, biscuits, and sweets are not allowed.

Reporting and Drop-Off Procedures

Kindly be reminded that reporting time is between **06:55 hrs and 07:05 hrs**. Please adhere to all road safety guidelines, including speed limits and signage. Use the designated drop-off area to avoid blocking school buses.

- Drop-off will continue in a single file within the yellow lines parallel to the classroom blocks.
- All vehicles must follow the designated entry and exit routes as indicated by road markings, cones, and traffic wardens.
- Please keep traffic moving; parking in the drop-off and pick-up zone, particularly in the morning, is not permitted.
- Drop-off and pick-up should not exceed 30 seconds to prevent congestion.
